5 (1) (a) A Any person, whether or not a citizen or resident 6 of this state, who personally or through an agent does any of 7 the acts enumerated in this subsection thereby submits himself 8 or herself and, if he or she is a natural person, his or her 9 personal representative to the jurisdiction of the courts of 10 this state for any cause of action arising from the doing of any 11 of the following acts:

12 <u>1.(a)</u> Operating, conducting, engaging in, or carrying on a 13 business or business venture in this state or having an office 14 or agency in this state.

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2. (b) Committing a tortious act within this state.

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3.(c) Owning, using, possessing, or holding a mortgage or 17 other lien on any real property within this state.

18 4.(d) Contracting to insure a any person, property, or risk located within this state at the time of contracting. 19

20 5.(e) With respect to a proceeding for alimony, child 21 support, or division of property in connection with an action to 22 dissolve a marriage or with respect to an independent action for support of dependents, maintaining a matrimonial domicile in 23 24 this state at the time of the commencement of this action or, if 25 the defendant resided in this state preceding the commencement 26 of the action, whether cohabiting during that time or not. This 27 paragraph does not change the residency requirement for filing an action for dissolution of marriage. 28

29 6.(f) Causing injury to persons or property within this 30 state arising out of an act or omission by the defendant outside 31 this state, if, at or about the time of the injury, either:

a.1. The defendant was engaged in solicitation or service 32 activities within this state; or 33

34 b.2. Products, materials, or things processed, serviced, or 35 manufactured by the defendant anywhere were used or consumed 36 within this state in the ordinary course of commerce, trade, or 37 use.

38 7.(g) Breaching a contract in this state by failing to 39 perform acts required by the contract to be performed in this 40 state.

8.(h) With respect to a proceeding for paternity, engaging 41 42 in the act of sexual intercourse within this state with respect to which a child may have been conceived. 43
