insert:

Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 817.312, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

817.312 Unlawful use of uniforms, medals, or insignia.—
(1) A person may not misrepresent himself or herself as a member or veteran of the United States Air Force, United States Army, United States Coast Guard, United States Marine Corps, United States Navy, or National Guard and wear the uniform of or any medal or insignia authorized for use by members or veterans of

13 the United States Air Force, United States Army, United States
14 Coast Guard, United States Marine Corps, United States Navy, or
15 the National Guard while soliciting for charitable contributions
16 or for the purpose of material gain. This section does not
17 prohibit persons in the theatrical profession from wearing such
18 uniforms, medals, or insignia while actually engaged in such
19 profession.
