22	consist of seven members. The Secretary of State shall appoint
23	three members to serve 3-year terms. The commission shall
24	appoint two members to serve 2-year terms and two members to
25	serve 4-year terms. Thereafter, the board shall be self-
26	appointed according to the established bylaws.
27	(c) The direct-support organization is subject to the
28	provisions of ss. 119.07 and 286.011, Florida Statutes, and s.
