An act relating to foreign-trained medical

professionals; amending s. 456.022, F.S.; prohibiting the Department of Health from issuing a license to, or renewing the license of, certain persons who travel to the Republic of Cuba to obtain medical training or a medical degree; providing an exemption; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (7) is added to section 456.022, Florida Statutes, to read:

456.022 Foreign-trained professionals; special examination and license provisions.-

(7) The department, for its boards, shall not issue an initial license to, or renew the license of, any applicant or licensee who is a citizen or resident of the United States and who travels to the Republic of Cuba to obtain medical training or a medical degree for a medical residency program or licensure under chapter 458 or chapter 459. This subsection does not apply to a resident national of the Republic of Cuba who receives medical training or obtains a medical degree before immigrating to the United States.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
