Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Delete lines 29 - 36
and insert:

(3) The marshal and his or her deputies shall be law enforcement officers as defined in s. 943.10(1), under the direction and control of the Supreme Court with full powers to bear arms and make arrests in accordance with the laws of this state. In performance of their official duties for the Supreme Court, they may apprehend without warrant a person disturbing the peace and deliver that person to the appropriate law enforcement officer of the municipality or county in which further proceedings may be held according to law.
