6 Section 1. Subsection (18) of section 196.012, Florida
 7 Statutes, is amended to read:

8 196.012 Definitions.—For the purpose of this chapter, the
 9 following terms are defined as follows, except where the context
 10 clearly indicates otherwise:

11 (18) "Permanent residence" means that place where a person
 12 has his or her true, fixed, and permanent home and principal
 13 establishment to which, whenever absent, he or she has the
 14 intention of returning. A person may have only one permanent
 15 residence at a time; and, once a permanent residence is
 16 established in a foreign state or country, it is presumed to
 17 continue until the person shows that a change has occurred. The
 18 permanent residence of a person incarcerated in a state
 19 correctional institution as defined in s. 944.02 or similar
