(To county): 2.85 for each 12-month period registered. 24 25 Class 1-16 feet or more and less than 26 feet in length: 26 \$28.75 for each 12-month period registered. 27 (To county): 8.85 for each 12-month period registered. 28 Class 2-26 feet or more and less than 40 feet in length:

(1) LICENSE, PERMIT, OR AUTHORIZATION NUMBER REQUIRED.-

60 (a) Except as provided in s. 379.353, no person shall take 61 game, freshwater or saltwater fish, or fur-bearing animals 62 within this state without having first obtained a license, 63 permit, or authorization number and paid the fees set forth in this chapter. Such license, permit, or authorization number 64 65 shall authorize the person to whom it is issued to take game, freshwater or saltwater fish, or fur-bearing animals, and 66 participate in outdoor recreational activities in accordance 67 with the laws of the state and rules of the commission. 68

69 (b) In 2013 and every 5 years thereafter, license and 70 permit fees established in subsections (4) and (5) shall be 71 adjusted by the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index 72 for All Urban Consumers since the fees were last adjusted, 73 unless otherwise provided by general law. By February 1 of each year in which an adjustment is scheduled to occur, the Fish and 74 75 Wildlife Conservation Commission shall submit a report to the 76 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of 77 Representatives detailing how the increase in license and permit 78 fees will be used within the agency. The license and permit fee 79 increases shall take effect July 1 of each adjustment year. 80 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
