33 468.631 Building Code Administrators and Inspectors Fund.-This part shall be funded through a surcharge, to be 34 (1)assessed pursuant to s. 125.56(4) or s. 166.201 at the rate of 35 36 1.5 percent of all permit fees associated with enforcement of 37 the Florida Building Code as defined by the uniform account criteria and specifically the uniform account code for building 38 39 permits adopted for local government financial reporting 40 pursuant to s. 218.32. The minimum amount collected on any 41 permit issued shall be \$2. The unit of government responsible 42 for collecting permit fees pursuant to s. 125.56 or s. 166.201 43 shall collect such surcharge and shall remit the funds to the 44 department on a quarterly calendar basis beginning not later than December 31, 2010, for the preceding quarter, and 45 continuing each third month thereafter; and such unit of 46 government shall retain 10 percent of the surcharge collected to 47 48 fund the participation of building departments in the national 49 and state building code adoption processes and to provide 50 education related to enforcement of the Florida Building Code. 51 There is created within the Professional Regulation Trust Fund a 52 separate account to be known as the Building Code Administrators 53 and Inspectors Fund, which shall deposit and disburse funds as 54 necessary for the implementation of this part.
