Amendment

Remove lines 569-590 and insert:

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7 (a) Before the beginning of each fiscal year, the
8 corporation shall submit its annual operating budget, as
9 approved by the corporation board, for the fiscal year and set
10 forth that amount to the department in writing. One-fourth of
11 the operating budget shall be transferred to the corporation
12 each quarter. The department shall make the first one-fourth
13 quarter transfer on the first business day of the fiscal year
14 and make the remaining one-fourth quarter transfers before the
15 second business day of the second, third, and fourth quarters.
16 The corporation board may approve changes to the operational
17 budget for a fiscal year by providing written notification of
18 such changes to the department. The written notification must
19 indicate the changes to the operational budget and the
20 conditions that were unforeseen at the time the corporation

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21 developed the operational budget and why the changes are
22 essential in order to continue operation of the corporation.

23 (b) The corporation shall periodically submit requests to
24 the department for the transfer of funds to the corporation
25 needed to make payments to mobile home owners under the
26 relocation program. Requests must include documentation
27 indicating the amount of funds needed, the name and location of
28 the mobile home park, the number of approved applications for
29 moving expenses or abandonment allowance, and summary
30 information specifying the number and type, single-section or
31 multisection, of homes moved or abandoned. The department shall
32 process requests that include such documentation, subject to the
33 availability of sufficient funds within the trust fund within 5
34 business days after receipt of the request. Transfer requests
35 may be submitted electronically.

36 (c) Funds transferred from the trust fund to the
37 corporation shall be transferred electronically and shall be
38 transferred to and maintained in a qualified public depository
39 as defined in s. 280.02 which is specified by the corporation.

40 (4) Other than the requirements specified under this
41 section, neither the corporation nor the department are required
42 to take any other action as a prerequisite to accomplishing the
43 provisions of this section.

44 (5) This section does not preclude department inspection
45 of corporation records 5 business days after receipt of written
46 notice.
