An act relating to students with limited English proficiency; amending s. 1003.56, F.S.; authorizing exemption from certain state standardized assessments up to a specified period if certain conditions are met; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (5) of section 1003.56, Florida Statutes, is renumbered as subsection (6), and a new subsection (5) is added to that section to read:

1003.56 English language instruction for limited English proficient students.—

(5) A student with limited English proficiency who has received services for 2 years or less in an ESOL program operated in accordance with an approved school district English language learner plan may be exempt from taking the FCAT, end-of-course assessments, common core state standards assessments, or any future state standardized academic assessment if a majority of the student's English language learner committee determines that it is appropriate.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
