5 Between lines 42 and 43, insert:

6 Section 2. Section 1001.41, Florida Statutes is amended to read:
 7 1001.41 General powers of district school board.—The
 8 district school board, after considering recommendations
 9 submitted by the district school superintendent, or after
 10 considering recommendations made by a member of the board, shall
 11 exercise the following general powers:

12 (1) Determine policies and programs consistent with state
 13 law and rule deemed necessary by it for the efficient operation
 14 and general improvement of the district school system.

15 (2) Adopt rules pursuant to ss. 120.536(1) and 120.54 to
 16 implement the provisions of law conferring duties upon it to
 17 supplement those prescribed by the State Board of Education and
 18 the Commissioner of Education.

19 (3) Prescribe and adopt standards and policies to provide
 20 each student the opportunity to receive a complete education

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21 program, including language arts, mathematics, science, social
22 studies, health, physical education, foreign languages, and the
23 arts, as defined by the Sunshine State Standards. The standards
24 and policies must emphasize integration and reinforcement of
25 reading, writing, and mathematics skills across all subjects,
26 including career awareness, career exploration, and career and
27 technical education.

28 (4) Contract, sue, and be sued. The district school board
29 shall constitute the contracting agent for the district school
30 system.

31 (5) Perform duties and exercise those responsibilities
32 that are assigned to it by law or by rules of the State Board of
33 Education or the Commissioner of Education and, in addition
34 thereto, those that it may find to be necessary for the
35 improvement of the district school system in carrying out the
36 purposes and objectives of the education code.

37 (6) Assign students to schools.

38 (7) Enter into agreements for accepting credit card,
39 charge card, and debit card payments as compensation for goods,
40 services, tuition, and fees, as authorized by law.
