Between lines 565 and 566, insert:

Section 23. Subsection (6) of section 290.0055, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

290.0055 Local nominating procedure.-

(6) (a) The department may approve a change in the boundary of any enterprise zone which was designated pursuant to s. 290.0065. A boundary change must continue to satisfy the requirements of subsections (3), (4), and (5).

(b) Upon a recommendation by the enterprise zone development agency, the governing body of the jurisdiction which authorized the application for an enterprise zone may apply to the department for a change in boundary once every 3 years by adopting a resolution that:

1. States with particularity the reasons for the change;

21 2. Describes specifically and, to the extent required by
22 the department, the boundary change to be made.

23 (c) At least 90 days before adopting a resolution seeking
24 a change in the boundary of an enterprise zone, the governing
25 body shall include in a notice of the meeting at which the
26 resolution will be considered an explanation that a change in
27 the boundary of an enterprise zone will be considered and that
28 the change may result in loss of enterprise zone eligibility for
29 the area affected by the boundary change.

30 (d)1. The governing body of a jurisdiction which has
31 nominated an application for an enterprise zone that is at least
32 15 square miles and less than 20 square miles ~~no larger than 12~~
33 ~~square miles~~ and includes a portion of the state designated as a
34 rural area of critical economic concern under s. 288.0656(7) may
35 apply to the department to expand the boundary of the existing
36 enterprise zone by not more than 3 square miles. ~~An application~~
37 ~~to expand the boundary of an enterprise zone under this~~
38 ~~paragraph must be submitted by December 31, 2012.~~

39 2. The governing body of a jurisdiction which has
40 nominated an application for an enterprise zone that is at least
41 20 square miles and includes a portion of the state designated
42 as a rural area of critical economic concern under s.
43 288.0656(7) may apply to the department to expand the boundary
44 of the existing enterprise zone by not more than 5 square miles.

45 3. An application to expand the boundary of an enterprise
46 zone under this paragraph must be submitted by December 31,
