6 Section 7. Section 570.087, Florida Statutes, is created
 7 to read:

8 570.087 Best Management Practices for Wildlife.—The Fish
 9 and Wildlife Conservation Commission and the Florida Department
 10 of Agriculture and Consumer Services have long recognized that
 11 agriculture provides a valuable benefit to the conservation and
 12 management of fish and wildlife in Florida and have agreed to
 13 enter into a memorandum of agreement to develop and adopt by
 14 rule voluntary best management practices for the state's
 15 agriculture industry which reflect the industry's existing
 16 contribution to the conservation and management of freshwater
 17 aquatic life and wild animal life in the state.

18 (1) The department shall enter into a memorandum of
 19 agreement with the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission for
 20 the purpose of developing the best management practices

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21 contemplated by this section and their application on
22 agricultural lands within the state. This agreement may allow
23 for selected pilot projects in order to better facilitate the
24 development of the best management practices.

25 (2) The department is authorized to adopt rules
26 establishing the best management practices contemplated by this
27 section for the state's agricultural industry. Such rules must
28 also incorporate provisions for a notice of intent to implement
29 the best management practices and a system to assure the
30 implementation of the best management practices, including
31 recordkeeping requirements.

32 (3) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary,
33 including s. 163.3162, the implementation of the best management
34 practices contemplated by this section is voluntary and except
35 as specifically provided herein as to the department and section
36 9, article IV of the Florida Constitution as to the Fish and
37 Wildlife Conservation Commission, no agency, department,
38 district, or any unit of local government may exercise any of
39 its powers to adopt or enforce any ordinance, resolution,
40 regulation, rule or policy regarding the best management
41 practices on land classified as agricultural land pursuant to s.
42 193.461.
