29 Environmental Regulation Commission and are exempt from 30 ratification under s. 120.541(3). As part of the rule 31 development process, the department shall hold at least one 32 public workshop in the vicinity of the water body or water body 33 segment for which the total maximum daily load is being 34 developed. Notice of the public workshop shall be published not 35 less than 5 days nor more than 15 days before the public workshop in a newspaper of general circulation in the county or 36 37 counties containing the water bodies or water body segments for 38 which the total maximum daily load calculation and allocation 39 are being developed.
