Between lines 111 and 112 of the amendment, insert:

Section 3. Effective July 1, 2014, Subsections (1) and (2)  
of section 316.0083, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

316.0083 Mark Wandall Traffic Safety Program;  
administration; report.—

(1)(a) For purposes of administering this section, the  
department, a county, or a municipality may authorize a traffic  
infraction enforcement officer under s. 316.640 to issue a  
traffic citation for a violation of s. 316.074(1) or s.  
316.075(1)(c)1. Neither a notice of violation nor and a traffic  
citation may not be issued under this section for a right on red  
violation for failure to stop at a red light if the driver is  
making a right-hand turn in a careful and prudent manner at an  
intersection where right-hand turns are permissible. This  
paragraph does not prohibit a review of information from a

21 traffic infraction detector by an authorized employee or agent  
22 of the department, a county, or a municipality before issuance  
23 of the traffic citation by the traffic infraction enforcement  
24 officer. This paragraph does not prohibit the department, a

26 in paragraph (b) to the registered owner of the motor vehicle or  
27 to another person identified as having care, custody, or control  
28 of the motor vehicle involved in the violation of s. 316.074(1)  
29 or s. 316.075(1)(c)1. unless the notification is for a right on  
30 red violation.
