21 restricted driving privilege pursuant to a hearing under
22 subsection (2).

23 (a) For purposes of this subsection, a previous conviction
24 outside of this state for driving under the influence, driving
25 while intoxicated, driving with an unlawful blood-alcohol level,
26 or any other alcohol-related or drug-related traffic offense
27 similar to the offense of driving under the influence as
28 provided in s. 316.193 is considered a previous conviction for a
29 violation of s. 316.193, and a conviction for violation of
30 former s. 316.028, former s. 316.1931, or former s. 860.01 is
31 also considered a conviction for a violation of s. 316.193.

32 (b) The reinstatement shall be restricted to business
33 purposes only, as defined in this section, for the duration of
34 the suspension imposed under s. 322.2615.

35 (c) Acceptance of the reinstated driving privilege as
36 provided in this subsection is deemed a waiver of the right to
37 formal and informal review under s. 322.2615. The waiver may not
38 be used as evidence in any other proceeding.
