8 (s) The application form for motor vehicle registration
9 and renewal registration must include language permitting a
10 voluntary contribution of \$1 or more per applicant, which
11 contribution must be distributed to Auto Club Group Traffic
12 Safety Foundation, Inc., a nonprofit organization. Funds
13 received by the foundation must be used to improve traffic
14 safety culture in communities through effective outreach,
15 education, and activities in the state that will save lives,
16 reduce injuries, and prevent crashes. The foundation must comply
17 with s. 320.023.
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19 For the purpose of applying the service charge provided in s.
20 215.20, contributions received under this subsection are not
21 income of a revenue nature.

23 Section 32. Subsection (7) of section 322.08, Florida

27 (7) The application form for an original, renewal, or
28 replacement driver license or identification card shall include
29 language permitting the following:

30 (a) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which

32 for organ and tissue donor education and for maintaining the
33 organ and tissue donor registry.

34 (b) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
35 contribution shall be distributed to the Florida Council of the
36 Blind.

37 (c) A voluntary contribution of \$2 per applicant, which
38 shall be distributed to the Hearing Research Institute,
39 Incorporated.

40 (d) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
41 shall be distributed to the Juvenile Diabetes Foundation
42 International.

43 (e) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
44 shall be distributed to the Children's Hearing Help Fund.

45 (f) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
46 shall be distributed to Family First, a nonprofit organization.

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47 (g) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to Stop
48 Heart Disease, which shall be distributed to the Florida Heart
49 Research Institute, a nonprofit organization.

50 (h) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to Senior
51 Vision Services, which shall be distributed to the Florida
52 Association of Agencies Serving the Blind, Inc., a not-for-
53 profit organization.

54 (i) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant for
55 services for persons with developmental disabilities, which
56 shall be distributed to The Arc of Florida.

57 (j) A voluntary contribution of \$1 to the Ronald McDonald
58 House, which shall be distributed each month to Ronald McDonald
59 House Charities of Tampa Bay, Inc.

60 (k) Notwithstanding s. 322.081, a voluntary contribution
61 of \$1 per applicant, which shall be distributed to the League
62 Against Cancer/La Liga Contra el Cancer, a not-for-profit
63 organization.

64 (l) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to
65 Prevent Child Sexual Abuse, which shall be distributed to
66 Lauren's Kids, Inc., a nonprofit organization.

67 (m) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
68 shall be distributed to Prevent Blindness Florida, a not-for-
69 profit organization, to prevent blindness and preserve the sight
70 of the residents of this state.

71 (n) Notwithstanding s. 322.081, a voluntary contribution
72 of \$1 per applicant to the state homes for veterans, to be
73 distributed on a quarterly basis by the department to the State

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74 Homes for Veterans Trust Fund, which is administered by the
75 Department of Veterans' Affairs.

76 (o) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to the
77 Disabled American Veterans, Department of Florida, which shall
78 be distributed quarterly to Disabled American Veterans,
79 Department of Florida, a nonprofit organization.

80 (p) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant for
81 Autism Services and Supports, which shall be distributed to
82 Achievement and Rehabilitation Centers, Inc., Autism Services
83 Fund.

84 (q) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to
85 Support Our Troops, which shall be distributed to Support Our
86 Troops, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit organization.

87 (r) A voluntary contribution of \$1 or more per applicant
88 to the Auto Club Group Traffic Safety Foundation, Inc., a
89 nonprofit organization. Funds received by the foundation must be
90 used to improve traffic safety culture in communities through
91 effective outreach, education, and activities in the state that
92 will save lives, reduce injuries, and prevent crashes. The
93 foundation must comply with s. 322.081.
