7 (a) Record the final order as a judgment lien against any
 8 real or personal property within the state pursuant to s.
 9 997.55. Upon recording the order imposing the fine with the
 10 clerk of the circuit court, the order shall be deemed a judgment
 11 for purposes of chapter 55; or

12 (b) Seek garnishment of any wages to satisfy the amount of
 13 the fine, or any unpaid portion thereof, pursuant to chapter 77.
 14 Upon recording the order imposing the fine with the clerk of the
 15 circuit court, the order shall be deemed a judgment for purposes
 16 of garnishment pursuant to chapter 77.

17 (3) If a person holds an interest of \$10,000 or less in a
 18 single motor vehicle as defined in s. 320.01, that interest is
 19 exempt from the collection methods authorized by this section.
