Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove lines 315-348 and insert:

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 6 3. No member of the Legislature, appointed state officer,
 7 or statewide elected officer shall personally represent another
 8 person or entity for compensation before the government body or
 9 agency of which the individual was an officer or member for a
 10 period of 2 years following vacation of office. No member of the
 11 Legislature shall personally represent another person or entity
 12 for compensation during his or her term of office, or for a
 13 period of 2 years following vacation of office, before any state
 14 agency other than judicial tribunals or in settlement
 15 negotiations after the filing of a lawsuit. No member shall
 16 associate as a partner, principal, employee of a firm, or
 17 consultant for a period of 2 years following vacation of office
 18 for the purpose of drafting, strategizing, consulting, advising
 19 or in any way working on matters that will come before the

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20 Legislature or provide networking or relationship building
21 services with sitting members of the Legislature. For purposes
22 of this prohibition, employment, partnership, or association
23 with a principal, firm, or entity whose primary purpose is
24 legislative lobbying is presumptively prohibited unless the
25 principal, firm, entity, or former member first receives an
26 advisory opinion from the commission finding that the proposed
27 employment is in compliance with this section. If the primary
28 purpose of the employer, association, or partnership, principal,
29 firm, or entity affiliating with the former member is
30 legislative lobbying, such entity must file annually a sworn
31 statement with the Secretary of the Senate or the Clerk of the
32 House of Representatives affirming that the former member did
33 not engage in any of the prohibited activities.
