Remove lines 307-320 and insert:

3. No member of the Legislature, appointed state officer, or statewide elected officer shall personally represent another person or entity for compensation before the government body or agency of which the individual was an officer or member for a period of 2 years following vacation of office. No member of the Legislature shall personally represent another person or entity for compensation during his or her term of office, or for a period of 2 years following vacation of office, before any state agency other than judicial tribunals or in settlement negotiations after the filing of a lawsuit. No member shall associate as a partner, principal, employee of a firm, or consultant for a period of 2 years following vacation of office

17 for the purpose of drafting, strategizing, consulting, advising
 18 or in any way working on matters that will come before the
 19 Legislature or provide networking or relationship building
 20 services with sitting members of the Legislature. For purposes
 21 of this prohibition, employment, partnership, or association
 22 with a principal, firm, or entity whose primary purpose is
 23 legislative lobbying is presumptively prohibited unless the
 24 principal, firm, entity, or former member first receives an
 25 advisory opinion from the commission finding that the proposed
 26 employment is in compliance with this section. If the primary
 27 purpose of the employer, association, or partnership, principal,
 28 firm, or entity affiliating with the former member is
 29 legislative lobbying, such entity must file annually a sworn
 30 statement with the Secretary of the Senate or the Clerk of the
 31 House of Representatives affirming that the former member did
 32 not engage in any of the prohibited activities.
