6 Section 1. Subsection (5) of section 985.437, Florida
7 Statutes, is renumbered as subsection (6), subsections (1), (2),
8 and (4) are amended, and a new subsection (5) is added to that
9 section, to read:

10 985.437 Restitution.—

11 (1) The court that has jurisdiction over an adjudicated
12 delinquent child may, by an order stating the facts upon which a
13 determination of a sanction and rehabilitative program was made
14 at the disposition hearing, order the child and the child's
15 parent or guardian to make restitution in the manner provided in
16 this section. This order shall be part of the child's probation
17 program to be implemented by the department or, in the case of a
18 committed child, as part of the community-based sanctions
19 ordered by the court at the disposition hearing or before the
20 child's release from commitment.
