Senate Resolution

A resolution recognizing the Turkish American Federation of the Southeast and applauding its efforts to bridge cultural divides and celebrate diversity.

WHEREAS, South Florida is home to the third-largest Turkish population in the nation and, each spring, tens of thousands of Floridians attend the Turkish Festival organized by the Anatolia Cultural Center which features contemporary and traditional varieties of Turkish music, performing arts, and historic Ottoman marchers, and

WHEREAS, the Turkish American Federation of the Southeast is comprised of 22 Turkish and Turkic nonprofit and nongovernmental organizations in this and four other southern states and was established to improve the relationship between Turkic and American communities through educational, cultural, business, and other community endeavors, and

WHEREAS, the Turkish American Federation of the Southeast is hosting an annual art and essay contest for middle school and high school students in which they are encouraged to explore cultural differences through creative works of art or the written word, and

WHEREAS, in February 2010, the Turkish American Chamber of Commerce of the Southeast launched an annual business "matchmaking program" in which business owners and chief executive officers from Turkish companies visited Atlanta, Georgia, to explore import-export opportunities with local companies, and
