House Resolution A resolution designating April 2, 2013, as "FSU Day" in the State of Florida.

5 WHEREAS, the main campus of Florida State University in 6 Tallahassee is the oldest continuous site of higher education in 7 Florida and chartered the state's first chapter of Phi Beta 8 Kappa, the nation's oldest academic honor society, in 1935, and

9 WHEREAS, in 1994, Florida State University joined an elite 10 group of the nation's top research universities, being 11 designated a "Research I" institution by the Carnegie 12 Foundation, and

WHEREAS, Florida State University currently offers graduate and undergraduate degrees in 324 programs within 16 independent colleges and schools, taught by a faculty of 1,737 members, which has included nine National Academy of Sciences members and six Nobel Laureates, and

WHEREAS, Florida State University's fall 2012 freshman class was one of the most academically accomplished freshman classes in the university's history, with an average high school grade point average of 4.0, an average SAT score of 1857, and an average composite ACT score of 28, as well as an average high school grade point average of 4.35 among honors students, and
