House Resolution 1 2 A resolution recognizing Bay County on the occasion of 3 its centennial celebration. 4 5 WHEREAS, an act providing for the creation of Bay County 6 was passed by the Legislature of the State of Florida during its 7 regular session on April 24, 1913, and 8 WHEREAS, this act took effect and was in force on and after 9 the first day of July, 1913, and 10 WHEREAS, Bay County is located in the heart of Florida's 11 Great Northwest, overlooking the beautiful emerald green waters 12 of the Gulf of Mexico with 41 miles of sugar-white sandy 13 beaches, and 14 WHEREAS, with 270 square miles of water, Bay County's pristine lakes, springs, and streams, as well as the magnificent 15 St. Andrews Bay, provide excellent fishing, water sports, and 16 17 other activities and distinguish Bay County as one of the most 18 ecologically diverse areas in the great State of Florida, and WHEREAS, with a total of 1,033 square miles, Bay County's 19 20 beautiful beaches and diverse inland areas attract millions of visitors from all over the world each year, and its educated and 21 22 enthusiastic workforce creates a wonderful business environment 23 for residents and visitors alike, and 24 WHEREAS, Bay County is composed of seven incorporated 25 municipalities, including Panama City as the county seat, Lynn 26 Haven, Springfield, Parker, Callaway, Panama City Beach, and
