105	with s. 189.404(3), Florida Statutes, the following are the
106	minimum requirements for the charter of the North St. Lucie
107	River Water Control District:
108	(1) The district is organized and exists for all purposes
109	set forth in this act and chapter 298, Florida Statutes.
110	(2) The district's charter may be amended only by special
111	act of the Legislature.
112	(3) In accordance with chapter 189, Florida Statutes, this
113	act, and ss. 298.11 and 298.12, Florida Statutes, the governing
114	board of the district shall be designated the "Board of
115	Supervisors of the North St. Lucie River Water Control District"
116	and shall be composed of three persons, who shall be qualified
117	to hold such office if they are landowners within the district,
118	residents of the state, and citizens of the United States,
119	elected on a one-acre, one-vote basis by the owners of
120	assessable land in the district; however, landowners owning less
121	than one assessable acre in the aggregate shall be entitled to
122	one vote. Landowners owning more than one assessable acre shall
123	be entitled to one additional vote for any fraction of an acre
124	greater than one-half acre owned, when a landowner's acreage has
125	been aggregated for purposes of voting. The membership and
126	organization of the governing board shall be as set forth in
127	this charter and chapter 298, Florida Statutes, provided this
128	charter controls with respect to any inconsistency.
129	(4) The compensation of the governing board members shall
130	be governed by chapter 298, Florida Statutes.
