**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

Between lines 1568 and 1569  
insert:

Section 25. There is established a pilot program for the School District of Palm Beach County to recognize its business partners. The school district may recognize its business partners by publicly displaying the names of the business partners on school district property in the unincorporated areas of the county. Recognitions of project graduation and athletic

11 sponsorships are examples of appropriate recognitions. The  
12 school district shall make every effort to display the names of  
13 its business partners in a manner that is consistent with the  
14 county standards for uniformity in size, color, and placement of  
15 the signs. If the provisions of this section are inconsistent  
16 with county ordinances or regulations relating to signs in the  
17 unincorporated areas of the county or inconsistent with chapter  
18 125, Florida Statutes, or chapter 166, Florida Statutes, the  
19 provisions of this section shall prevail. If the Federal Highway  
20 Administration determines that the Department of Transportation  
21 is not providing effective control of outdoor advertising as a  
22 result of a business partner recognition by the school district  
23 under this program, the department shall notify the school  
24 district by certified mail of any nonconforming recognition, and  
25 the school district shall remove the recognition specified in  
26 the notice within 30 days after receiving the notification. The  
27 pilot program expires June 30, 2015.
