An act relating to the School Board of Lee County; providing for a referendum to increase the number of school board members from five to seven; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. (1) Upon submission by the School Board of Lee County of a proposition to increase the number of school board members from five to seven, the Supervisor of Elections of Lee County shall submit the proposition to the qualified electors of Lee County in a general election. Before the proposition is submitted to the electors, the school board must adopt a plan of apportionment for the seven-member board. The proposition submitted by the school board shall include a ballot statement, and the plan must be included as part of the ballot statement.
- (2) If the proposition is approved by the electors, the school board has the authority to establish a seven-member board according to the plan adopted by the school board and approved by the electors.
- (3) Such a proposition shall not be submitted to the electors more than once in any 5-year period.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
