24	Florida, seeking input regarding revisions to s. 1004.28,
25	Florida Statutes. The interim study shall be completed and a
26	report of its findings submitted to the chair and members of the
27	Higher Education and Workforce Subcommittee of the House of
28	Representatives by January 1, 2015.
29	Section 3. The Office of the Auditor General of the
30	Florida Legislature shall conduct an analysis of potential
31	conflicts of interest as well as recent historical incidents of
32	conflicts that have arisen from private funding of state
33	universities and other public institutes of higher education.
34	The Auditor General's report shall research any adverse effect
35	on ethics within public institutes of higher education and
36	recommend measures to prevent such conflicts of interest from
37	occurring. The Auditor General shall conduct a cost benefit
38	analysis that details the costs and benefits to donors as well

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39	as the costs of such arrangements borne by the taxpayer in
