practical nurses, certified nursing assistants, or home health aides referred under this part. If a registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, certified nursing assistant, or home health aide referred for contract in a private residence by a nurse registry violates any provision of this part or has a deficiency in credentials that comes to the attention of the nurse registry, the sole obligation of the nurse registry shall be to advise the patient to terminate the referred individual.

(20) A nurse registry shall maintain a repository of records required to be filed in accordance with this chapter and agency rules. A nurse registry is not required to review or act upon such records except as required under subsection (19).

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
