(5) It is a violation of this section:

37 (a) To carry <u>more passengers</u> a passenger on an off-highway

Any person who violates this section commits a 40 (6) 41 noncriminal infraction and is subject to a fine of not less than 42 \$100 and may have his or her privilege to operate an off-highway 43 vehicle ATV on public lands revoked. However, a person who 44 commits such acts with intent to defraud, or who commits a 45 second or subsequent violation, is subject to a fine of not less than \$500 and may have his or her privilege to operate an off-46 47 highway vehicle ATV on public lands revoked.

The term "ROV" does not include a golf cart as defined 77 in ss. 320.01 and 316.003(68) or a low-speed vehicle as defined 78 in s. 320.01.
