Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

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Between lines 1484 and 1485

4 insert: 5

Section 25. Subsection (3) of section 338.26, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

338.26 Alligator Alley toll road.-

- (3) (a) Fees generated from tolls shall be deposited in the State Transportation Trust Fund and shall be used: , and any amount of funds generated annually in excess of that required
 - 1. To reimburse outstanding contractual obligations; 7

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- 2. To operate and maintain the highway and toll facilities, including reconstruction and restoration;
- 3. To pay for those projects that are funded with Alligator Alley toll revenues and that are contained in the 1993-1994 adopted work program or the 1994-1995 tentative work program submitted to the Legislature on February 22, 1994;, and
- 4. To design develop and construct operate a fire station at mile marker 63 on Alligator Alley, which may be used by a county or another local governmental entity to provide fire, rescue, and emergency management services to the public on adjacent counties along Alligator Alley; and
- 5. By interlocal agreement effective July 1, 2014, through no later than June 30, 2018, to reimburse a county or another local governmental entity for the direct actual costs of operating the fire stations between mile markers 34 and 35 and at mile marker 63 on Alligator Alley.
- (b) Funds generated annually in excess of those required to pay the expenses in paragraph (a)_{τ} may be transferred to the Everglades Fund of the South Florida Water Management District. The South Florida Water Management District shall deposit funds for projects undertaken pursuant to s. 373.4592 in the Everglades Trust Fund pursuant to s. 373.45926(4)(a). Any funds remaining in the Everglades Fund may be used for environmental projects to restore the natural values of the Everglades, subject to compliance with any applicable federal laws and regulations. Projects must shall be limited to:
- 1. (a) Highway redesign to allow for improved sheet flow of water across the southern Everglades.
 - 2. (b) Water conveyance projects to enable more water



resources to reach Florida Bay to replenish marine estuary functions.

3.(c) Engineering design plans for wastewater treatment facilities as recommended in the Water Quality Protection Program Document for the Florida Keys National Marine Sanctuary.

4.(d) Acquisition of lands to move STA 3/4 out of the Toe of the Boot, provided such lands are located within 1 mile of the northern border of STA 3/4.

5.(e) Other Everglades Construction Projects as described in the February 15, 1994, conceptual design document.
