7 Section 2. Paragraph (e) of subsection (2) of section
 8 320.0848, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

9 320.0848 Persons who have disabilities; issuance of
 10 disabled parking permits; temporary permits; permits for certain
 11 providers of transportation services to persons who have
 12 disabilities.—

13 (2) DISABLED PARKING PERMIT; PERSONS WITH LONG-TERM
 14 MOBILITY PROBLEMS.—

15 (e) To obtain a replacement for a disabled parking permit
 16 or parking permit decal that has been lost or stolen, a person
 17 must submit an application on a form prescribed by the

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18 department, provide a certificate of disability issued within
19 the last 12 months pursuant to subsection (1), and pay a
20 replacement fee in the amount of \$1, to be retained by the
21 issuing agency. If the person submits with the application a
22 police report documenting that the permit was stolen, there is
23 no replacement fee.

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
