Section 2. Subsections (1) and (2) of section 465.189,

Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

465.189 Administration of vaccines and epinephrine autoinjection.-

(1) In accordance with guidelines of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for each recommended immunization or vaccine, a pharmacist may administer the following vaccines



12 to an adult within the framework of an established protocol 13 under a supervising physician licensed under chapter 458 or 14 chapter 459: 15 (a) Influenza vaccine. 16 (b) Pneumococcal vaccine. 17 (c) Meningococcal vaccine. 18 (d) Shingles vaccine. 19 (2) In accordance with quidelines of the Centers for 2.0 Disease Control and Prevention, a pharmacist may administer the 21 shingles vaccine within the framework of an established protocol 22 and pursuant to a written or electronic prescription issued to
