2 An act relating to the City of Ocala, Marion County;
3 defining the term "Ocala Downtown Community
4 Redevelopment Area"; authorizing the Division of
5 Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of the Department of
6 Business and Professional Regulation to issue to a
7 bona fide nonprofit civic organization a specified
8 number of additional temporary permits to sell
9 alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises at
10 certain events in the Ocala Downtown Community
11 Redevelopment Area; providing requirements to obtain
12 the temporary permit; providing an effective date.

14 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

16 Section 1. (1) As used in this act, the term "Ocala
17 Downtown Community Redevelopment Area" means that area of the
18 City of Ocala in Marion County which is bounded on the north by
19 NW 20th Street, on the west by Pine Avenue, on the south by SW
20 10th Street, and on the east by Sanchez Avenue to NE 3rd Street,
21 Watula Avenue from NE 3rd Street to SE 8th Street, and SE
22 Magnolia Avenue from SE 8th Street to SW 10th Street.

23 (2) Notwithstanding any provision of law, the Division of
24 Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of the Department of Business
25 and Professional Regulation may issue to a bona fide nonprofit
26 civic organization up to 15 temporary permits per calendar year

27 authorizing the sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption on
28 the premises at outdoor events in the Ocala Downtown Community
29 Redevelopment Area. Such temporary permits shall be valid for up
30 to 3 days.

31 (3) To obtain a temporary permit under this act, a bona
32 fide nonprofit civic organization must:

33 (a) Present a valid resolution to the division from the
34 Ocala City Council which grants temporary approval for
35 possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages on municipally
36 owned property and authorizes closure of affected streets if
37 public rights-of-way are included in the permitted premises; and

38 (b) Comply with all other requirements of s. 561.422,
39 Florida Statutes.

40 (4) The temporary permits authorized by this act are in
41 addition to the temporary permits authorized per year for a bona
42 fide nonprofit civic organization pursuant to s. 561.422,
43 Florida Statutes.

44 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
