Amendment

5 Remove lines 112-158 and insert:

6 voting members appointed by the Governor as follows:

7 1. Eight members representing concrete masonry
 8 manufacturers of various sizes upon receipt of recommendations
 9 from the Masonry Association of Florida, at least five of whom
 10 must be representatives of manufacturers that are members of the
 11 Masonry Association of Florida. A manufacturer may not be
 12 represented by more than one board member.

13 2. One member representing a major building industry
 14 association in the state.

15 3. One member having expertise in apprenticeship or
 16 workforce education training.

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17 4. One member who is not a masonry contractor or
18 manufacturer or an employee of a masonry contractor or
19 manufacturer but who is otherwise a stakeholder in the masonry
20 industry.

21 5. Two members who are masonry contractors and who are
22 members of the Masonry Association of Florida.

23 (b)1. Five of the initial board members shall be appointed
24 to serve 1-year terms, four of the initial board members shall
25 be appointed to serve 2-year terms and four of the initial board
26 members shall be appointed to serve 3-year terms.

27 2. Each subsequent vacancy on the board of directors shall
28 be filled in accordance with the initial appointment.

29 Thereafter, each board member shall be appointed to serve a 3-
30 year term and may be reappointed to serve an additional
31 consecutive term. However, a member may not serve more than two
32 consecutive terms.

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
