20	their 14th Atlantic Coast Conference Championship, and
21	WHEREAS, on January 6, 2014, under Coach Fisher and his
22	coaching staff and Director of Athletics Stan Wilcox, the top-
23	ranked Seminoles earned a 34-31 victory over second-ranked
24	Auburn University in the 2014 Vizio Bowl Championship Series
25	(BCS) National Championship Game in Pasadena, California, and
26	WHEREAS, together with the 1950 and 1999 Seminoles football
27	teams that concluded their seasons with undefeated records, the
28	2013 Florida State Seminoles' 14-0 record marks the third
29	perfect season in school history, and
