(3) (a) In order to monitor the humane treatment of racing greyhounds, each licensed greyhound track shall maintain records regarding injuries incurred by racing greyhounds while they are racing in this state, including injuries incurred in schooling races. The records must include:

- 11 1. The greyhound's registered name, right and left ear tattoo numbers, and, if applicable, the microchip manufacturer 12 13 and number.
 - 2. The name, business address, and telephone number of the greyhound owner and trainer and the kennel operator.
 - 3. The color, weight, and sex of the greyhound.
 - 4. The location where the injury occurred.
 - 5. If the injury occurred while the greyhound was racing, the racetrack where the injury occurred and the distance, grade, race, and post position of the greyhound when the injury occurred.
 - 6. The weather conditions, time, and track condition when the injury occurred.
 - 7. The specific type and bodily location of the injury, the cause of the injury, and the estimated recovery time from the injury.
 - (b) All injury records shall be completed and signed under oath or affirmation under penalty of perjury by the racetrack veterinarian, whose signature must be witnessed by a designated representative of the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services or the Division of Pari-mutuel Wagering.
 - (c) Injury records created and maintained under this subsection shall be filed monthly with the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services with an inspector designated by the department. Injury records shall also be maintained by the track for a period of 7 years and shall be made readily available for inspection and copying by the public upon oral or written request.
 - (d) A person who knowingly makes a false statement on an



40 injury record is subject to a fine not to exceed \$1,500.
