and insert:

Section 55. The governing body of a municipality that created a downtown development authority and was authorized to levy an additional ad valorem tax under chapter 65-1090, Laws of Florida, may continue to levy said additional ad valorem tax on all real and personal property in the downtown district of up to 0.5 mill for the purpose of financing the operation of the authority. The levy of the ad valorem tax shall be in addition

12 to regular ad valorem taxes and special assessments for
13 improvements imposed by the governing body of the municipality;
14 however, the combined levy may not exceed the maximum millage
15 authorized for municipal purposes under s. 9(b), Article VII of
16 the State Constitution.
