

- 27 1. Attended a high school in this state for at least 3
28 consecutive or nonconsecutive school years;
- 29 2. Graduated from a high school in this state or attained
30 a high school equivalency diploma pursuant to s. 1003.435;
- 31 3. Registered as an entering student or is currently
32 enrolled at a state university or a Florida College System
33 institution; and
- 34 4. If he or she is without lawful immigration status,
35 files an affidavit with the state university or the Florida
36 College System institution at which he or she is registered or
37 enrolled stating that he or she has filed an application to
38 legalize his or her immigration status or will file an
39 application as soon as he or she is eligible to do so.
- 40 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
