29 chapter 459, or chapter 460, ~~or~~ certified under s. 464.012, who
30 is and in good standing with his or her professional ~~the~~
31 ~~practitioner's~~ regulatory board, shall administer the medical
32 evaluation. The bylaws shall establish requirements for
33 eliciting a student's medical history and performing the medical
34 evaluation required under this paragraph, which shall include a
35 physical assessment of the student's physical capabilities to
36 participate in interscholastic athletic competition as contained
37 in a uniform preparticipation physical evaluation and history
38 form. The evaluation form shall incorporate the recommendations
39 of the American Heart Association for participation
40 cardiovascular screening and shall provide a place for the
41 signature of the practitioner performing the evaluation with an
42 attestation that each examination procedure listed on the form
43 was performed by the practitioner or by someone under the direct
44 supervision of the practitioner. The form shall also contain a
45 place for the practitioner to indicate if a referral to another
46 practitioner was made in lieu of completion of a certain
47 examination procedure. The form shall provide a place for the
48 practitioner to whom the student was referred to complete the
49 remaining sections and attest to that portion of the
50 examination. The preparticipation physical evaluation form shall
51 contain information that advises a student ~~advise students~~ to
52 complete a cardiovascular assessment that includes an

53 electrocardiogram. The preparticipation physical evaluation form
54 ~~and~~ shall also include information concerning alternative
55 cardiovascular evaluation and diagnostic tests. Results of such
56 medical evaluation must be provided to the school. A ~~No~~ student
57 is not ~~shall be~~ eligible to participate in any interscholastic
58 athletic competition or engage in any practice, tryout, workout,
59 or other physical activity associated with the student's
60 candidacy for an interscholastic athletic team until the results
61 of the medical evaluation have been received and approved by the
62 school. The FHSAA shall make available to the parent of each
63 student literature on the importance of a preparticipation
64 cardiovascular assessment that includes an electrocardiogram.
