26 Section 2. Subsection (5) of section 626.932, Florida 27 Statutes, is amended to read: 626.932 Surplus lines tax.-

- The department shall deposit 8.8 percent of all taxes collected under this section into the Insurance Regulatory Trust Fund. Ninety-one and two-tenths percent of all taxes collected under this section shall be deposited into the General Revenue Fund.
- Section 3. Subsection (7) of section 626.938, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
- 626.938 Report and tax of independently procured coverages.-
- The department shall deposit 8.8 percent of all taxes (7) and interest collected under this section into the Insurance Regulatory Trust Fund. Ninety-one and two-tenths percent of all taxes and interest collected under this section shall be deposited into the General Revenue Fund.
- Section 4. Effective June 30, 2014, section 9 of chapter 2009-70, Laws of Florida, is repealed.
- Section 5. Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act and except for this section, which shall take effect upon this act becoming a law, this act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
