Section 56. Subsections (1) and (2) of section 465.189, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

465.189 Administration of vaccines and epinephrine autoinjection.-

(1) In accordance with guidelines of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for each recommended immunization or vaccine, a pharmacist may administer the following vaccines



to an adult within the framework of an established protocol under a supervising physician licensed under chapter 458 or chapter 459:

- (a) Influenza vaccine.
- (b) Pneumococcal vaccine.
- (c) Meningococcal vaccine.
- (d) Shingles vaccine.
- (2) In accordance with quidelines of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, a pharmacist may administer the shingles vaccine within the framework of an established protocol and pursuant to a written or electronic prescription issued to the patient by a physician licensed under chapter 458 or chapter 459.
