Between lines 197 and 198
insert:

Section 4. Subsections (1) and (4) of section 1009.89,
Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

1009.89 The William L. Boyd, IV, Florida resident access
grants.-

(1) The Legislature finds and declares that independent
nonprofit colleges and universities eligible to participate in
the William L. Boyd, IV, Florida Resident Access Grant Program

27 residency, for student eligibility as provided in s. 1009.40,
28 except as otherwise provided in this section; ~~and~~

29 (b)1. He or she is enrolled as a full-time undergraduate
30 student at an eligible college or university;

31 2. He or she is not enrolled in a program of study leading
32 to a degree in theology or divinity; and

33 3. He or she is making satisfactory academic progress as
34 defined by the college or university in which he or she is
35 enrolled; and

36 (c) He or she demonstrates a financial need.

44 student, as a prerequisite for the Florida Academic
45 Scholars award, the Florida Medallion Scholars award,
46 or the Florida Gold Seal Vocational Scholars award, to
47 identify a social or civic issue or a professional
48 area of interest and develop a plan for his or her
49 personal involvement in addressing the issue or
50 learning about the area; prohibiting the student from
51 receiving remuneration or academic credit for the
52 volunteer service work performed; providing examples
53 of volunteer service work; requiring that the hours of
54 volunteer service work performed be documented in
55 writing and the document be signed by the student, the
56 student's parent or guardian, and a representative of
57 the organization for which the student performed the
58 volunteer service work; deleting obsolete provisions;
