4 Remove lines 1198-1279 and insert:

5 Therefore, the Agency for Health Care Administration shall
6 create content that is easily accessible through the home page
7 of the agency's website either directly or indirectly through
8 links to one or more other established websites of the agency's
9 choosing. The website must be searchable by facility name,
10 license type, city, or zip code. By November 1, 2014, the agency
11 shall include all content in its possession on the website and
12 add content when received from facilities. At a minimum, the
13 content must include:

14 (1) Information on each licensed assisted living facility,

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15 including, but not limited to:

16 (a) The name and address of the facility.

17 (b) The number and type of licensed beds in the facility.

18 (c) The types of licenses held by the facility.

19 (d) The facility's license expiration date and status.

20 (e) Proprietary or nonproprietary status of the licensee.

21 (f) Any affiliation with a company or other organization
22 owning or managing more than one assisted living facility in
23 this state.

24 (g) The total number of clients that the facility is
25 licensed to serve and the most recently available occupancy
26 levels.

27 (h) The number of private and semiprivate rooms offered.

28 (i) The bed-hold policy.

29 (j) The religious affiliation, if any, of the assisted
30 living facility.

31 (k) The languages spoken by the staff.

32 (l) Availability of nurses.

33 (m) Forms of payment accepted, including, but not limited
34 to, Medicaid, Medicaid long-term managed care, private
35 insurance, health maintenance organization, United States
36 Department of Veterans Affairs, CHAMPUS program, or workers'
37 compensation coverage.

38 (n) Indication if the licensee is operating under
39 bankruptcy protection.

40 (o) Recreational and other programs available.

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- 41 (p) Special care units or programs offered.
- 42 (q) Whether the facility is a part of a retirement
43 community that offers other services pursuant to this part or
44 part III of this chapter, part II or part III of chapter 400, or
45 chapter 651.
- 46 (r) Links to the State Long-Term Care Ombudsman Program
47 website and the program's statewide toll-free telephone number.
- 48 (s) Links to the websites of the providers or their
49 affiliates.
- 50 (t) Other relevant information that the agency currently
51 collects.
- 52 (2) Survey and violation information for the facility,
53 including a list of the facility's violations committed during
54 the previous 60 months, which on July 1, 2014, may include
55 violations committed on or after July 1, 2009. The list shall be
56 updated monthly and include for each violation:
- 57 (a) A summary of the violation, including all licensure,
58 revisit, and complaint survey information, presented in a manner
59 understandable by the general public.
- 60 (b) Any sanctions imposed by final order.
- 61 (c) The date the corrective action was confirmed by the
62 agency.
- 63 (3) Links to inspection reports that the agency has on
64 file.
- 65 (4) The agency may adopt rules to administer this section.
