14	Section 1. Subsection (12) of section 790.06, Florida
15	Statutes, is amended to read:

17	(12)(a) A license issued under this section does not
18	authorize <u>a</u> any person to openly carry a handgun or carry a
19	concealed weapon or firearm into:
20	1. <u>A</u> Any place of nuisance as defined in s. 823.05;
21	2. <u>A</u> Any police, sheriff, or highway patrol station;
22	3. <u>A</u> Any detention facility, prison, or jail;
23	4. <u>A</u> Any courthouse;
24	5. <u>A</u> Any courtroom, except that nothing in this section
25	would preclude a judge <u>may carry</u> from carrying a concealed
26	weapon or <u>determine</u> determining who <u>may</u> will carry a concealed
