The Legislature finds that it is a public necessity that data, programs, or supporting documentation that is a trade secret as defined in s. 812.081, Florida Statutes, that is held by an agency as defined in chapter 119, Florida Statutes, and that resides or exists internal or external to an electronic device be made confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1), Florida Statute, and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution. The public release of such data, programs, and supporting documentation would negatively impact the business interests of those providing an agency such trade secrets by damaging the business in the marketplace. record exemption, those entities and individuals disclosing such trade secrets would hesitate to cooperate with that agency, which would impair the effective and efficient administration of governmental functions. Thus, the public and private harm in disclosing data, programs, or supporting documentation that is a trade secret, and that resides or exists internal or external to an electronic device, significantly outweighs any public benefit derived from disclosure, and the public's ability to scrutinize and monitor agency action is not diminished by the nondisclosure of such trade secrets.
