14	25, 2015, through 6:00 a.m. on July 26, 2015, on the sale at
15	retail, as defined in s. 212.02(14), Florida Statutes, of any
16	item or article of tangible personal property, as defined in s.
17	212.02(19), Florida Statutes, in this state.
18	(2) The tax exemption provided in subsection (1) does not
19	apply to the online sale of an item or article of tangible
20	personal property conducted over the Internet.
21	(3) The tax exemption provided in subsection (1) does not
22	apply to the sale of any item or article of tangible personal
23	property that is not paid for in full during the period
24	described in subsection (1).
25	(4) The Department of Revenue may, and all conditions are
26	deemed met to, adopt emergency rules pursuant to ss. 120.536(1)
