6 and distributed under this chapter, or any interest earned from  
7 those fees, may not be used for commercial or for-profit  
8 activities nor for general or administrative expenses, except as  
9 authorized by s. 320.08058 or to pay the cost of the audit or  
10 report required by s. 320.08062(1). The fees and any interest  
11 earned from the fees may be expended only for use in this state  
12 unless the annual use fee is derived from the sale of United  
13 States Armed Forces and veterans-related specialty license

17 expenses" means those expenditures which are considered as

21 the organization who do not or cannot prove, via detailed daily  
22 time sheets, that they actively participate in program  
23 activities.

24 2. Bookkeeping and support services of the organization.

25 3. Office supplies and equipment not directly utilized for  
26 the specified program.

27 4. Travel time, per diem, mileage reimbursement, and  
28 lodging expenses not directly associated with a specified  
29 program purpose.

30 5. Paper, printing, envelopes, and postage not directly  
31 associated with a specified program purpose.

32 6. Miscellaneous expenses such as food, beverage,  
33 entertainment, and conventions.

45 private use or recreational vehicle as specified in s.  
46 320.08(9) (c) or (d), which is not used for hire or commercial  
47 use, who is a resident of the state and a veteran of the United  
48 States Armed Forces, an active or retired member of the Florida  
49 National Guard, a survivor of the attack on Pearl Harbor, a  
50 recipient of the Purple Heart medal, an active or retired member  
51 of any branch of the United States Armed Forces Reserve, or a  
52 recipient of the Combat Infantry Badge or Combat Action Badge  
53 shall, upon application to the department, accompanied by proof  
54 of release or discharge from any branch of the United States  
55 Armed Forces, proof of active membership or retired status in  
56 the Florida National Guard, proof of membership in the Pearl  
57 Harbor Survivors Association or proof of active military duty in  
58 Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941, proof of being a Purple Heart  
59 medal recipient, proof of active or retired membership in any  
60 branch of the Armed Forces Reserve, or proof of membership in  
61 the Combat Infantrymen's Association, Inc., or other proof of  
62 being a recipient of the Combat Infantry Badge or Combat Action  
63 Badge, and upon payment of the license tax for the vehicle as  
64 provided in s. 320.08, be issued a license plate as provided by  
65 s. 320.06, upon which, in lieu of the serial numbers prescribed

67 Guard," "Pearl Harbor Survivor," "Combat-wounded veteran," "U.S.

70 Additionally, the Purple Heart plate may have the words "Purple  
71 Heart" stamped on the plate and the likeness of the Purple Heart  
72 medal appearing on the plate.
