22 Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public  
23 necessity to exempt from s. 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and s.  
24 24(a), Article I of the State Constitution personal identifying  
25 information about individuals held by the Department of  
26 Transportation, a county, a municipality, or an expressway  
27 authority for the purpose of paying, prepaying, or collecting  
28 tolls and associated administrative charges due for the use of  
29 toll facilities. The Legislature also finds that it is a public  
30 necessity that this exemption apply to personal identifying  
31 information held by the Department of Transportation, a county,  
32 a municipality, or an expressway authority before, on, or after
