(9) (a) Beginning in the 2014-2015 fiscal year, the sum of 6 7 \$5 million in recurring funds is appropriated from the General 8 Revenue Fund to the Department of Military Affairs to pay the full tuition and fees, not to exceed the in-state rate at the 9 10 applicable state college or state university, for members 11 deployed on or after October 31, 2013.
